II. Eligibility

(Applicants who have completed the entire curriculum in their country of residency in less than 12 years will also be acknowledge.) Regardless of the nationality, residency and length of stay of the guardian will be supported. 		

- * In case of Korean Language Proficiency Test score unavailability, applicants must meet one of the following conditions.
 - Those who have obtained minimum Social Integration Program Level 3 or "intermediate level1" in the King Sejong Institute.
 - Those who have obtained minimum Level 3 in the Korean language education institution and passed level 3 Korean Language Test administered by Yewon Art University. (Y-TOPIC)
- * For applicants with an English Track course, TOEFL iBT 80, IESTS 5.5, TEPS 550 or equivalent has to be obtained.
- In case of English Language Proficiency Test score unavailability, applicants must meet one of the following conditions.
 - Passed English Language Test administered by Yewon Art University
 - Passed Interview at Yewon Art University
- ** Upon graduation from the undergraduate program or graduate school (master's program), student must pass the Korean Language Proficiency Test level 3 or higher (level 4 or higher in the humanities and social sciences field) or the school's own Korean Language Proficiency Test level 3 or higher (level 4 or higher in the humanities and social sciences field). Likewise, upon graduation from the English track, student must pass the nationally recognized English Proficiency Test or the school's own English test with TOEFL iBT 80, IESTS 5.5, TEPS 550 or equivalent scores.

2. Precautions for submitting the documents

- A. Graduation certificates and transcripts of records during elementary, middle, and high school must be translated into Korean if written in other language excluding English. Documents must be in A4 size (210×296mm), notarized authorized notary office and submitted together with the original documents.
- B. Documents must be submitted on or before the deadline with the original copies. But if a copy unavailable the original must be brought and submitted.
- C. Applicants must submit the original documents after the final pass and registration.
- D. High school graduates from overseas must submit a graduation certificate and a final transcript of records before the start of admission.
- E. Domestic school transcript of records must be submitted to the school life record book.

- F. If the names on the submitted documents are different, a certificate of the same person issued by the court of the country concerned must be attached.
- G. Applicants must comply with the request to submit additional documents. If you do not submit, you will be excluded from the admission process.

IV. Application process and Fee

2. Important Notes for Application

- A. All information must be filled out accurately and in accordance with the instructions for entry. Errors and omissions will be penalized.
- B. Applications that have already been submitted cannot be amended, canceled or returned.
- C. Since applicants do not go through a separate recommendation procedure like the recommendation from the Secretary of State, Director of Overseas Missions, City Superintendent and the like, must bring and submit the documents necessary for application screening. In case of submitting on other's behalf, accurately understanding the applicant's educational background, overseas residence, stay, and enrollment is a must.
- D. Applicant's aspirations are limited to the first choice.
- E. Applicant who has been accepted to two or more universities must enroll in only one university. Admission to two or more universities will be denied.
- F. Applicants for on-time admission cannot apply multiple times to other universities at the same admission period of the university.
- G. Applicant who has been admitted to a university in violation of the provisions of the above paragraphs shall have his or her admission void or revoked.

3. Precautions for application

- A. After receiving the application, contact number must be provided in case of emergency.
- B. False information in the documents will result to the the cancellation of the admission even if the applicant has passed the screening already.

V. Procedure for selection

1. Reviewing of Documents and Interview

- A. Examination on applicant's eligibility of academic background, immigration status and authenticity of documents are carried out continuously and comprehensively. Results of eligibility are not announced in batches. Students who are having problems during the screening process will be contacted individually.
- B. Must comply with the request to submit additional required documents for eligibility.

VI. Announcement and Registration of Successful Applicants

1. Announcement of Admission Results

- A. Announcements will be made through the school's website, etc... Applicants must check the list of successful applicants and follow all the instruction upon passing the exam. There will be no individual notifications.
- B. Successful applicants must download the acceptance letter and schedule of tuition from the website and pay the prescribed fee to be confirmed as a successful applicant.

VII. Completion of Graduate Curriculum

- 1) Regular Enrollment Semester: 4 semesters
- 2) Depending on the applicant's desire, master's degree can be received by submitting a dissertation or taking additional credits.
- 3) It is possible to obtain a degree through presentation of works without submitting a thesis. However this only applies for Graduate school of Culture and Arts and excluding Physical Education majors.
